**OHIO EXTENDS DUE DATE TO FILE AND PAY INCOME TAXES**

The Ohio Department of Taxation, in conjunction with an [announcement](#) from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), is extending the due date to file and pay Ohio individual and school district income taxes by one additional day, from April 17, 2018 to April 18, 2018. Individuals do not need to do anything to receive this extra time.

The IRS extended the federal filing deadline because technical problems prevented taxpayers from using its online payment system for much of yesterday's original filing due date.
