Ohio Sales and Use Tax Rate Change Notice

The sales and use tax rates will change for the following counties effective **January 1, 2005**.

Hardin County (33)	7.00%	to	7.50%	(Increase)
Mahoning County (50)	7.00%	to	6.50%	(Decrease)
Richland County (70)	7.25%	to	6.75%	(Decrease)

This rate change notification includes rates and codes to be used in filing the Ohio Universal Sales Tax Return, form UST-1 and the Ohio Universal Use Tax Return, form UUT-1.

Ohio law has been changed to require retailers/vendors to charge sales tax on goods and services based on the location where the customer takes delivery (destination-based) as opposed to where the vendor is located. This will not affect the vast majority of vendors that sell merchandise that is carried away from the vendor's location by customers. The change was implemented to be in line with Streamlined Sales Tax Project (SSTP). There will be a six-month transition period for implementing this change. Vendors may voluntarily start collecting sales tax based on the destination on January 1, 2005. On July 1, 2005, the change is mandatory. In order to help you determine what county and rate to collect for a particular address, the Ohio Department of Taxation has developed a new online application called The Finder. You may search for any valid Ohio address, zip code, zip code plus 4 extensions, or latitude and longitude coordinates. To use this new application, please go to our website at www.tax.ohio.gov and click on The Finder. This will take you to a page that has information as well as a tutorial to help you navigate through the various features available in The Finder.

Beginning this year, all semiannual vendors will be using the same 2 semiannual periods. The first, January 1 through June 30, the second July 1 through December 31. The due dates will remain the same, the 23rd day of the month following the ending day of the period.
