

Sales and Use Tax Rate Changes effective April 1, 2022

There will be four (4) sales and use tax rate changes effective April 1, 2022.

- The sales and use tax rate for Coshocton County (16) will increase from 7.25 % to 7.75 % effective April 1, 2022.
- The sales and use tax rate for Mahoning County (50) will increase from 7.25 % to 7.50 % effective April 1, 2022.
- The Toledo Area Regional Transit Authority (TARTA) enacted a .50% sales and use tax effective April 1, 2022. The TARTA makes up the entirety of Lucas County and the City of Rossford in Wood County. **This rate increase does not apply to all of Wood County.**
 - The sales and use tax rate for the area that makes up the City of Rossford in Wood County (87) will increase from 6.75 % to 7.25 % effective April 1, 2022.
 - The sales and use tax rate for Lucas County (48) will increase from 7.25 % to 7.75 % effective April 1, 2022.
