PAYMENTS

The Tax Department is not authorized to set up a payment plan. Any partial payments submitted will be applied to the outstanding balance. Partial payments will not stop the imposition of additional interest, penalties or the referral of the account to the Ohio Attorney General's Office for collection.

The Attorney General's Office is the collection agent for the State of Ohio. When the Attorney General receives the account, a notice will be issued to you that will include the address and telephone number of their office. At that time, you may contact the Attorney General's office to arrange for a payment plan. They have the authority to authorize payment plans for up to one year.

Remember, your return and payment must be electronically filed or postmarked on or before the twenty-third of the month following the reporting period. Under Ohio sales and use tax law, the postmark date is considered to be the filing date. Failure to timely file and pay will result in an assessment which may include additional penalties.
